

D: Designated Hitter.**M: Player-Manager** (always at end of position codes),**/H: Pinch-Hitter** (used only if player had no other position).**/R: Pinch-Runner** (used only if player had no other position).

Position codes are followed by the number of games that the player played at that position during a season or in his career. Different positions are normally separated by commas, except when a slash (/) is used to indicate that the player played only one game at positions to the right of the slash. (No commas are used to separate such positions.)

Because the official statistics lump the three outfield positions into only one “outfield” position, the official number of games in the Outfield is always shown first with an *O*. If the player only played one outfield position in that year or in his career, that position will be identified by an *L*, *C*, or *R* after the number of games played.

If the player played two or three outfield positions in a year or in his career, a breakdown of the games in left, center, and right is presented in that order in parentheses, separated by slashes. When a player’s career breakdown of games in left, center, and right won’t fit in the Games at Position column totals line, that information has been added to the end of the player’s biographical information. *If so, the primary outfield position played will be identified by L, C, or R following the number of games played in the outfield in the totals line.*

DL: Disabled List. This new category of information—never-before-published in an encyclopedia—shows the number of days spent on the major league disabled list, year-by-year and for each player’s career. All DL assignments from 1941 to the present are shown. If a player was not disabled, his DL column will show zero for that year; if he was never disabled, his DL column will show zero for his career. Before 1941, when there was no DL, an em dash (—) is shown.

The **DL** column in the batter and pitcher registers shows the number of *days* (not *games*) missed by that player during the regular season while he was on the disabled list. If a player was assigned to the DL more than once during a particular season, the lengths of all his DL stints are combined. Time spent on the DL before Opening Day or after the last day of the regular season is not counted, which is why some players will have Days on DL data that is less than the minimum (currently 15 days).

A DL column entry of 166 or greater from 1941–58 indicates that a player spent the whole season on the DL since the length of the regular season in those years was 166–167 days. From 1959–68, the regular season was 171–174 days long, except for the 1960 AL (167 days), which opened almost a week later than the NL.

With expansion to two divisions in 1969, the regular season was stretched to 178–181 days, except in the strike year of 1972 (172 days). From 1982 to the present, the normal season has been 181–183 days long; in the last 20 years, the only seasons that were shorter than 182 days were due to lockouts or strikes in 1990 (178 days), 1994 (131),

and 1995 (160). Because of the interruption of the season caused by September 11, the 2001 season went a week longer than its scheduled 183 days. (Note that the early season-opening series in Japan in 2000 and 2004 were not counted as part of the regular-season length.)

If a player spent all or part of any season on the major league DL but did not play in any games that year, his DL information is shown in square brackets at the end of his bio line. The format for these entries is [DL Year Tm Lg Days on DL]. If a player (e.g., Albert Belle) spent time on the DL in more than one season in which he never played, these DL stints will be separated by commas inside a single set of square brackets in his bio line.

In the rare cases when a player was traded while on the DL, the number of days he spent on the DL is shown separately for each team, but no total is shown for that year. There are also a small number of zero-day DL stints where players were put on the DL in the off-season (typically in the spring) but were activated on or before Opening Day and didn’t miss any time during the regular season. If such a DL stint is the player’s only time on the DL in a given season, we show a zero in the DL column.

The forerunner of the modern DL was instituted in 1941. Aside from a brief experiment by the NL in 1915–16 with a Disabled List (from which no records of disabled players have been found), seriously injured players were simply sent home by major league teams and told to report back when they were healthy enough to play again. If the club wanted to retain future rights to injured players, they simply placed them on the Suspended or Voluntary Retired lists—meaning that injured players were removed from major league rosters and didn’t draw a salary, yet these same players still couldn’t try to sign on with any other team in Organized Baseball.

The rules for using the DL in the 1940s were quite strict: Only two players from a club could be on the DL at any one time, players had to spend at least 60 days on the DL, and no one could be placed on the DL after August 1. Because of these strict rules and the depletion of top-flight talent during World War II, major league clubs very rarely used the DL before the 1950s. Fewer than a dozen players total ever spent time on the DL before 1946, and the first season that more than 12 players were assigned to the DL was 1950.

After the 1949 season, the rules were liberalized so that players needed to spend only 30 days on the DL. Many other changes to the rules governing disabled players have been made since 1960; 15-day DL stints were allowed for the first time in 1966.

BFW: Batter-Fielder Wins. The sum of a player’s batting wins, basestealing wins, and fielding wins, this figure indicates how many games the player won or lost for his team compared to an average player.

For any missing data, such as CS, RBI or SO, the career total is underlined if it is a partial figure.
